## **GEOHealth Hub for Research and Capacity Building Announcement for Studentship (MPH & M.Sc.) 2019-20**

The Global Environmental and Occupational Health (GEOHealth) Hub on Air Pollution and Cardiovascular Disease is a joint effort of the Public Health Foundation of India, Centre for Chronic Disease Control and the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, and is funded by the Fogarty International Center of the National Institutes of Health. The Hub will focus on research and capacity building related to Air Pollution but will address other environmental and occupational health issues.

As part of this Hub's activities, there are MPH 65-credit (Environmental Health) and M.Sc. 80-credit (Environmental Health) studentships available to acquire the necessary skills and competencies to carry out work on environmental and occupational health. The Hub invites applications for Summer 2019 intake for the studentships.

### Description:

- ◆ Fully-funded MPH 65-credit degree/ M.Sc. 80-credit degree from the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health.
- ◆ Stipend of \$1800 approximately (NRSA level) for the duration of the programme
- ◆ Round-trip airfare to Boston

### Eligibility:

Candidates should hold a post-graduate degree and two or more years of experience in environmental health/public health, and must be willing to teach, if not already a faculty member. Candidates must have a **valid GRE & TOEFL/IELTS score** to apply; strong quantitative scores are preferable.

### Requirements:

As part of the initial submission and selection process, applicants are required to submit the following:

1. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
2. Statement of Purpose (SOP)
3. List of Referees
4. Official Transcripts/Mark sheets
5. GRE & TOEFL/IELTS scores (must be submitted along with application)
